**GENERAL INFO:**

The mission of the Rose City Hockey Club (RCHC) is to create a thriving youth ice hockey program for girls, which provides them with the skills needed to succeed on and off the ice. We're committed to making hockey accessible to all girls interested in the sport. At this time, we're excited to announce scholarships for our **2017 Dec 2-3 Seattle travel games**.

The purpose of our scholarship program is to help hockey families who otherwise could not afford the cost required to travel to a tournament. We believe each recipient should pay some portion of this fee and we will award grants accordingly, based on funding availability and each family's unique level of need. Carpooling and other ways of helping to reduce costs are also encouraged. How scholarship payments are made will be dependent upon which part of the tournament fees will be covered.

During the selection process, all financial information will be kept strictly confidential. In addition, the process will be "blind" meaning, to the maximum extent possible, teammates, volunteers, and other staff will not know which players are on scholarship. Criteria for receiving a scholarship include but are not limited to:

1. Demonstrated financial need;
2. Availability of funds;
3. A player's ability to participate in a majority of the tournament.
